Important information from Andromeda Forwarding & Logistics B.V. regarding SOLAS rules

Debbie Vrolijk-Lampen from Andromeda Forwarding & Logistics has provided us with important information below about SOLAS which we urge all members to take note of. Please note that this information was also sent to all members via the Mailing List on 16th June.

To ensure the safety of seafarers and shore-side workers, with effect **from 1 July 2016**, the members of the International Maritime Organization (IMO) will start enforcing the Safety of Life at Sea (SOLAS) amendments to require a packed container to have shipper-verified weight (VGM) as a condition for loading onto a ship for export.

This means that we as Andromeda must receive below information of every shipment for export seafreight:

Actual cargo weight without packing + weight of the packing materials used

Opposite you will find more details about the new VGM rule as per 01-07-2016. You can also view this information by [clicking here](#)

If we do not receive the requested information the rule is:

NO VGM – NO LOAD

Which means that your container will not be loaded on board and extra charges will occur which will be for account and risk of the shipper.

For every new booking as from week 26 we will inform you when the last date is that we need the cargo weight details (this may be different from the customs export document).
